Scholarship Name: <u>OppU Achievers Scholarship</u> **Award Amount**: \$2,500. **Eligibility**: High school seniors, college students, graduate students; cumulative GPA of at least 3.0/4.0; U.S. citizen or resident. **Deadline**: December 31, March 31, June 30, and September 30. **To Apply**: Students submit a short response to the question "What makes you an achiever?"

Daughters of American Agriculture Scholarship: \$1,000, 2 Awards. **Deadline**: March 1, 2021. To be eligible a student must be a woman planning on studying agriculture leadership, communications, rural sociology, medicine, or any other courses directly related to agriculture. Scholarship for Journalism Diversity: \$8,500. **Deadline:** March 1, 2021. You must be a high school senior with a grade point average of 3.0 or better who is preparing to enter college and

intends to become a journalist who will bring diversity to U.S. journalism to apply. Applications can be found by clicking <u>here</u>.

American Chemical Society Scholars Program: \$5,000, 350 Awards. **Deadline:** March 1, 2021. You must be a graduating high school senior or college freshman, sophomore, or junior to apply. Applications can be found by clicking <u>here</u>.

Project Yellow Light Video Scholarship: \$8,000, 6 Awards. **Deadline:** March 1, 2021. To be eligible for this scholarship you must be currently in high school or college and attending a college or University in the fall of 2021. Applications can be found by clicking <u>here</u>.

SEG Scholarship: \$10,000, 150 Awards. **Deadline:** March 1, 2021. To be eligible for the scholarship a student must be a high school senior planning to attend college next year. Microsoft Disability Scholarship: \$20,000, 10 Awards. **Deadline:** March 1, 2021. To be eligible for the scholarship a student must be a high school senior with a 2.5 or above GPA and enrolling in one of the following majors: Aerospace Engineering, Computer Engineering, Computer Science, Electrical Engineering, Industrial Engineering, Mechanical Engineering of Physics. Each year, the STEM Scholarship Program awards \$10,000 to 200 recipients studying engineering or computer science at a 4-year college or university.
