Calvin Coolidge Presidential Foundation: The Coolidge Scholarship: *January 2021,* Any **high school junior** who plans to enroll in college in the fall of 2022 and is an American citizen or legal

permanent resident is eligible to apply (current high school seniors are not eligible to apply). Coolidge scholars are selected primarily on academic excellence. Secondary criteria include: an interest in public policy, an appreciation for and understanding of the values President Coolidge championed, as well as humility and service. <u>https://coolidgescholars.org</u>

Virginia Junior Chamber International Senate (VA JCI Senate) Scholarship Program, *January* 2021, Each year, the U.S. Junior Chamber International (JCI) Senate Foundation grants \$1,000 scholarships to graduating high school seniors who plan to continue their education at accredited post-secondary colleges, universities or vocational schools. The number of grants awarded annually is at the discretion of the Foundation and must be used for educational expenses in the first year of full-time study. Rappahannock Electric Cooperative (REC) Community Scholarships, January 25, 2021, Each year Rappahannock Electric Cooperative offers the REC Community Scholarship program to students who are seeking to advance their career goals by attending a college or trade school. High school seniors nationwide who demonstrate leadership, drive, integrity, and citizenship are invited to apply for the 2021 GE-Reagan Foundation Scholarship Program. This program annually provides college-bound students with \$10,000 renewable scholarships – up to \$40,000 total per recipient – and supports them as they lead and serve in college and beyond.

Scholarship Name: <u>OppU Achievers Scholarship</u> **Award Amount**: \$2,500. **Eligibility**: High school seniors, college students, graduate students; cumulative GPA of at least 3.0/4.0; U.S. citizen or resident. **Deadline**: December 31, March 31, June 30, and September 30. **To Apply**: Students submit a short response to the question "What makes you an achiever?"

Jackie Robinson Foundation: National scholarship for minority students who demonstrate leadership potential, commitment to community service and financial need. Opens November 1, 2020. Deadline: February 1, 2021. Scholarship awards up to \$30,000 for four years.

Alzheimer's Awareness College Scholarship Essay contest: High School seniors planning to attend a post-secondary institution. Must write an essay describing the impact Alzheimer's disease has had on their life, their families, or their communities, and what they have learned in
