Scholarship Name: <u>OppU Achievers Scholarship</u> **Award Amount**: \$2,500. **Eligibility**: High school seniors, college students, graduate students; cumulative GPA of at least 3.0/4.0; U.S. citizen or resident. **Deadline**: December 31, March 31, June 30, and September 30. **To Apply**: Students submit a short response to the question "What makes you an achiever?"

Joel Bieber Firm Scholarship: \$1,000. **Deadline:** June 13, 2021. Students must have a 3.0 GPA, requires two essays, a letter of recommendation, and a high school transcript.

CIA Undergraduate Scholarship Program: \$18,000 – 10 Awards **Deadline:** June 18, 2021. To be eligible for the scholarship a student must have scored at least 1000 on the SAT or 21 on ACT and demonstrate financial need and have at least a 3.0 GPA on a 4-point scale. RF Wittmeyer Community Service Scholarship: \$1,000 – 1 Award **Deadline:** June 30, 2021.
